RANGE SAFETY RULES

1. All firearms must be unloaded when brought into The Hunters Den. Except for licensed permit to carry individuals. Those that have a carry permit must keep the firearm holstered until they are at their shooting stall or if the Rangemaster requests differently. Other firearms are to be cased or holstered. Revolvers without holster or a case will be carried by the top strap, cylinder open. Semi- autos will have the slide locked to the rear, magazine out.
2. The Rangemaster has full authority of the range at all times and will observe and take any action required to insure proper and safe shooting. This would include, but is not limited to, removal from the range and possible disciplinary action.
3. Firearms maybe loaded in the range stall only when pointed downrange, at the firing line, at the assigned stall. Firearms must not be loaded behind the firing line.
4. Only authorized firearms and ammunition may be used. No long guns or fully automatic weapons are permitted. Armor penetrating, tracer, and incendiary rounds are prohibited. Any rounds traveling over 2500 feet per second is prohibited unless specially authorized. Only .22LR and standard handgun rounds are allowed on the range unless specially authorized by the Range master.
5. Black powder and muzzle loading firearms are prohibited.
6. Do NOT throw any ammunition or empty shells into the trash containers. Clean up after yourself. Retrieval of brass only from behind the firing line. Front of the firing line belongs to The Hunters Den.
7. The use of alcohol or drugs is prohibited on the premises. Any person believed to be under the influence of any type of alcohol or drugs will be refused use of the range and will be required to leave the premises.
8. Use of the eye and ear protection is required at all times on the range.
9. While on the range, firearms must be pointed downrange at all times. When moved from the firing line, firearms must be holstered, cased or carried as stated in rule 1.
10. Should a misfire or other malfunction occur, keep the firearm pointed downrange and signal the Range master. If required, place the firearm on the stall table, pointed downrange, and obtain assistance. Do not leave the firing line with a loaded or jammed firearm.
11. Dry firing is allowed on the firing line only. Dry firing anywhere else on the premises is prohibited.

12. Firing at other than approved targets will result in revocation of range privileges and liability for damages. Shots to target trolleys, range fixtures, and equipment will result in additional charges per shot. Damage to range equipment resulting from negligence, carelessness, and inability to place shots on target will result in liability to repair or replace such damaged equipment.
13. Accidental discharges, damages or injuries must be reported to Range master immediately, no matter how trivial they may seem.
14. Never move forward of the firing line. If anything falls forward of the firing line, contact Range master for assistance.
15. Any unattended firearm must be in the condition of rule 1.
16. Smoking, eating, or drinking is prohibited on the range.
17. Rangemaster reserves the right to prohibit the use of any firearm that may or is deemed unsafe.
18. It is your sole responsibility – if pregnant – whether or not to utilize this facility.
19. Any person with a medical disorder, which might create a safety hazard, must notify Rangemaster before going out on the range.
20. Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times, both on and off the range. Parent/Guardian must sign indemnification before minor can be on the range. No one under the age of 8 allowed on the range.
21. Rangemaster will bar anyone handling a gun in an unsafe or inappropriate manner.
22. No more than one shooter allowed on a lane except with Rangemasters approval.
23. No center fire rifles unless they fire handgun ammunition. No rifle caliber handguns. No black powder.
24. No rapid – fire is permitted. Allow at least one second between shots.
25. Do not exchange weapons with another lane. Switch shooters, not guns.
26. CEASE FIRE: On this command, unload your weapon; open action, lay weapon down and step back from the line. Do not move back into the booth for any reason until cleared to do so by the Rangemaster.
27. Rental weapons must be used with range ammunition only.
28. Rental weapons should be returned empty with the action open or cylinder swung open.
29. Do NOT, under ANY circumstance, cause harm to yourself or others.
30. DO NOT PASS IN FRONT OF BOOTHS AT ANY TIME
